Syria Shrine Gun Club shoots trap once each month, year around usually on a Saturday at a Sportsman's Club to which one of our members belongs. In late summer, we shoot in competition against the Rajah (Reading) and Boumi (Baltimore) Shrine Gun Clubs with the host club rotating each year. A Tri-Shrine trophy is awarded to the winning Shrine and individual winners and runners-up are awarded trophies for each of the events in which they participate. The occasion is informal and Shrine fellowship is the order of the day. All of our shoots include the company our Ladies, some of whom shoot with us and are quite good at it!

Dues are a modest \$10.00/ year and membership in the Shrine is required. Guests, especially Masonic guests are *always* welcome to shoot with us. Following our monthly "practice" shoots, we usually hold our club business meeting and often adjourn to a local restaurant for an informal lunch. During the year, our members conduct various raffles and other fund-raisers in an effort to raise significant funds for the Shrine Hospitals for Children in Erie, Philadelphia and Cincinnati. We also are a major sponsor of the Syria Sporting Clays Shriners Hospital Charity shoot at 7-Springs. This effort is our major reason for being as we have fun and enjoy the sport and fellowship.
